The Epidemiology Section of the Michigan Public Health Association is calling for abstracts for poster and verbal presentations at its upcoming *Michigan Epidemiology Conference*, Friday, March 19, 2009 at the Michigan State University Union in East Lansing.

We are looking for abstracts from diverse disciplines including, but not limited to: state and local health departments, academia (including students), infection control, non-profit organizations, international health, private industry, and health care networks. Authors should feel free to submit epidemiology abstracts on any topic related to human health. Authors should be prepared to discuss their work during one of two half hour poster sessions.

Verbal Presentations

Presentations will be limited to 15 minutes, followed by a question and answer period.

Instructions for Submission:

- Please provide the following information in the Abstract Submission Form on the next page.
 - Authors and affiliations
 - Abstract of the presentation, including: title, introduction, materials/methods, results, and discussion. Please limit the total text in this section to 250 words.
 - The presenting author's mailing address, phone number and e-mail address
 - Whether the presenting author is a student or non-student
 - Preferred method of presentation: verbal, poster, or no preference. *The review committee will accommodate these preferences as much as possible, but in some cases may request alternative presentation methods.*
