

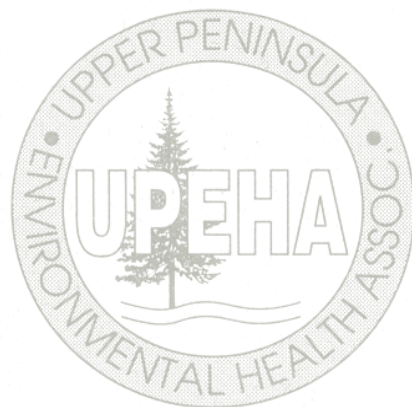
HOTEL INFORMATION
