

Summary of changes to SEMEHA Constitution and By-Laws 2019

1. Changing all instances of Southeastern (in Southeastern Michigan Environmental Health Association) to Southeast to reflect MEHA Constitution.
2. Removal of publications from Article II Section 2 (SEMEHA has not had a publication in many years).
3. Separating MEHA Director sections from Article II and creating new Article III. All Articles following new Article III and mentions of articles within constitution have been revised to reflect change.
4. Changing all instances of last meeting of each calendar year and regular meeting to General Membership meeting for clarity.
5. Removing term limits for region representatives in Article IV (new Article V) Section 2(b)
6. Changing of required number of general membership meetings from two to one in Article V (new Article VI) section 1.
7. Adding that Executive Board shall hold a minimum of three meetings throughout the year to Article V (new Article VI) section 4.
